#### **Rollerblading: History, Tips and Tricks!**

If you are a beginner in rollerblading, this article is the perfect fit for you! Here, you will learn the basics of roller bading, some simple tricks, and even its background! Your average skates should look something like this:

#### History

John Joseph Merlin, a Belgian man invented shoes with wheels on the soles in 1735. Monsieur Petitbled, in 1819, improvised and created inline skates with three wheels and no way of turning. Pretty useless, right? Then, James Leonard Plimpton improvised and created working skates with four wheels. This was in 1863. On his skates, you could simply steer by tilting yourself left or right. Then, in 1980, Scott and Brennan Olsen, two Minnesota brothers found some old inline skates at a store. They decided that they could make use of them. Soon enough, they were creating inline skates in their parents' basement. In 1983, Scott Olson founded Rollerblade, Inc. In short, rollerblades are people building on each other's ideas.



#### Tips

The first and most important tip: <u>WEAR YOUR **PROTECTIVE GEAR**!!!</u> No matter if you are a beginner, an intermediate skater, or a pro, please wear a helmet, knee, and elbow covers! When putting on your skates, the goal is to make sure your foot cannot slide around or shift back and forth in the skate. However, you also can't tie them too tight, or else your feet may be uncomfortable while skating or you could get hurt. To make sure this doesn't happen, after putting on your skates, roll around a bit to make sure you are 100% ready to go! While skating, keep your knees slightly bent and your back tilted in front. Your head should be a tiny bit above and in front of your shoulders. This **posture** will help you maintain your balance.

# Tricks

Some simple tricks in rollerblading for beginners are: going backwards, one foot skating, and **wavers**. Although skating backwards can be very challenging, once you learn to wave, it's *way* easier. To begin, put your feet in the shape of a V. You could also pick up speed before doing this, but don't go too fast as you might lose balance. Placing your feet like this will result in them going separate directions, so you have to be fast to shift both feet so your toes are pointing slightly inward. Repeating this, your feet will now be making a wave effect, moving in and out.

Now that you have mastered the wavers trick, **skating backwards** will be a piece of cake! For this, stand still on a flat surface. You will need a lot of leg strength to do this repeatedly, but going slow and taking your time is key. Place your feet in the same position when going back in in wavers. Now, push out and your skates will begin to roll backwards without much effort. This is like the opposite of waving, so to pick up speed bring your feet back in and out. Also, make sure to look behind your back so you don't run into anything!



The final trick is **one foot skating**. It is as simple as it sounds. The only challenging part is that you need *a lot* of balance. All you need to do is pick up some speed and lift one of your legs up. Make sure you also keep balance using your arms.

# Unbelievable Animals That Rule The Ocean

Have you ever wondered what it would be like to swim in a deep, mysterious ocean? Have you wondered about what you would see? There are many animals in the ocean that you might not even know exist! They come in many different shapes and sizes. Some have big teeth, while others, you can't even tell where their tails or heads are!

# **Goblin Sharks**

One of the weirdest creatures found in the ocean is the Goblin Shark, a species found in 1898 by David Starr Jordan. Many of them have been found in Honshu, Japan at the depths of 60-280 m. The shark is a slow swimmer with bad eyesight; it only eats small and big fish but brings no harm to humans. The article "Goblin Shark- National Geographic Kids" states, "A goblin shark's top and bottom teeth are attached to ligaments, or bands of skin tissue, tucked into its mouth. When prey is just out of reach, the shark extends the elastic tissue out of the mouth to nab the grub. This allows the animal to chow down on snacks such as teleost fish and squid. It also makes the shark one jaw-dropping fish!" This means that the shark has a huge mouth with many teeth and how it catches its prey.

# The Man Of War

Anyone unfamiliar with the biology of the venomous Portuguese man-of-war would likely mistake it for a jellyfish. Although present in warm seas all over the world, the man-of-war is most typically found in the Gulf Stream of the northern Atlantic Ocean and the tropical and subtropical portions of the Indian and Pacific oceans, where it can be found in millions. The body is a gas-filled, bladderlike float that is 9 to 30 cm (3 to 12 inches) in length and 15 cm (6 inches) in height above the water. It's a translucent structure with pink, blue, or violet tints. Polyps cluster beneath the float, their tentacles reaching as far as 50 meters (165 ft). Dactylozooid polyps, gonozooid polyps, and gastrozooid polyps are responsible for capturing prey, reproducing, and feeding, respectively.

# The Great Barracuda

The great Barracuda is a ray-finned with a frightening appearance and a big size. It has a long, compressed body that is coated with microscopic smooth scales. The barracuda is a salt water fish that belongs to the family sphyraenidae and may be found in tropical and subtropical oceans all over the world. Great barracuda attacks on humans are uncommon. Attacks by barracudas rarely result in fatalities. According to the article "Sphyraenidae Barracuda- discover fishes," a barracuda was blamed for a death off the coast of Key West in 1947, and another off the coast of North Carolina in 1957. In 1960, a free diver was attacked by a barracuda off the coast of Pompano Beach, Florida. Barracudas are scavengers who may mistake snorkelers for large predators and pursue them in the hopes of consuming their prey's remnants. Human attacks by barracudas are uncommon, yet bites

can cause lacerations and tissue damage. Barracudas have weak eyesight and are drawn to reflective, metallic items, mistaking them for silver fish, which is what they eat most often.

Man of War Jellyfish, Goblin Sharks, and the Great Barracuda are three distinct species that reside at incredible depths. The three species, which were largely discovered in the nineteenth century, are all fascinating and unique creatures, all hailing from various parts of the globe.

It's April 26, 1986 and you're in the middle of a dream with all your favorite comics and movies. All of a sudden, things start getting really dark, and you think you're in a simulation. You hear a loud boom and the air starts smelling weird and toxic. Then you wake up, and you look outside the window and see flashing lights and sounds. Your parents are packing up their things and you start heading down to the car.

At 1:23 AM in Chernobyl, Ukraine, reactor 4 went out of control during a safety test which led to an explosive fire that released large amounts of radiation into the Chernobyl-Pripyat area. The core of the reactor melted down and exploded twice. The combination of the operator's carelessness and the reactor's design flaws made the reactor primed to explode. After the reactor exploded, it immediately killed 30 operators working at the reactor. It also injected 4,000-16,000 people with a high dose of radiation. which killed them in a couple years following the accident. Approximately 117,000 people had to be evacuated from the 19-mile radioactive zone.

The accident cost about 235 billion dollars in damage. It took about 500,000 people and roughly 68 billion dollars to make the reactor safer. A sarcophagus was built around the reactor in November of 1986, but a new much stronger food, drinks, and celebration. The preparation of Ofrendas (altars) to honor loved ones, who have passed away as they make their trip to Earth, is one of the most important traditions of this festival. Rows of lit candles represent the fire element and can be found on altars. These candles are meant to illuminate the way for spirits to return home.

To conclude, there are many qualities about Mexico that you may not be aware of, as well as many lovely places to explore. These are only a few of the most frequently known traditions. Mexico is a great country that you should visit some day with many wonderful folks that can show you around. My personal experiences growing up as a Mexican American allowed me to learn and teach all of this information about Mexican culture.

Lurking in the depths of the reactor's ruins, is something called "elephant's foot." Elephant's foot is a highly radioactive object and is considered to be one of the most dangerous substances in the world. It consists of corium, which is a lava-like substance made out of fuel. About 300 seconds in the presence of the substance will lead to immediate death. 35 years after the accidents, the elephant's foot is safer and is now more like sand than corium.

One of the most famous abandoned places of the aftermath is the ghost town of Pripyat. In April of 1986, Pripyat had about 45,000 people living in it. It was a very quickly growing town in Soviet times, and large numbers of people had to leave their homes because of the disaster a couple miles away.

One of the most famous abandoned destinations in Pripyat, is the abandoned ferris wheel. When the disaster struck, the theme park was still in construction and was never open to the public. Now, the wheel is abandoned and could be visited legally.

Another really famous place in Pripyat is the Azure swimming pool. The Azure swimming pool got its fame because it was featured in a famous video game called "Call of Duty 4: Modern Warfare" and was made as a map in the game. The pool did not officially close until 1998, 12 years after the accident.

Lastly, the Pripyat Secondary School Number 2 is known for its abandoned classrooms. It contained gas masks, abandoned toys, soviet propaganda, and just regular classroom items. Most buildings in Pripyat and Chernobyl are empty, but not the schools in the zone. The items in the school have no value to looters since they aren't any prized possessions and could be found in any other abandoned soviet school.

The Disaster of Chernobyl and Pripyat were extremely depressing events and made thousands of people evacuate and leave their homes for years. The explosion infected many people with high amounts of radiation and later killed them. The events reflect on Soviet times and the consequences of the Cold War.

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
#### **Boxing** By: Artur Ashurov

First let's try jabs. Jabs are a basic move and your opponent won't get hurt as much as a hook or an uppercut. A jab is when you punch forward. A hook is when you swing your fist; most hooks are aimed at the face, but you can hook someone in the body. An upper cut is different. This is when you aim under the chin. When you punch, you have to twist your hand, or if you're practicing without boxing gloves, you have to put your thumb on your fist, not inside your fist; if you put your thumb inside your fist, there is a chance it can break. When you punch, you have to step once with your front foot. And you have to put your hands up at all times. A pretty neat trick is when you block your face with your hands, and use your elbows to block your body if your opponent punches you in the body.
